PräKasch

Case press

The **PräKasch** machine is a toggle-lever case press designed to press down book cases, posters, calendar backs etc. after turning-in.

Handling as well as output of the **PräKasch** machine are well-suited to the **PräDeck** case maker and the **PräKant** turning-in machine.

The machine is equipped with a removable rubber plate. The book case, poster etc. is placed onto this plate and is then moved into the press.

There are two versions of rubber plates available:

- a plate for book cases which has a thicker area in the centre to press down the spine
- a flat plate for pressing down posters etc.

The advantage of the **PräKasch** over pressing-down machines with rollers is that if bubbles are building between cardboard and cover, no creases occur when they are pressed down.

Models:

- **PräKasch:** Size 60 x 40 cm, desktop model
- **PräKasch U:** Size 60 x 40 cm, with stand
- **PräKasch XL:** Size 85 x 52 cm, desktop model
- **PräKasch XL-U:** Size 85 x 52 cm, with stand

The stands may be equipped with swivel castors against surcharge.
